This show will be held out-of-doors on Bermuda grass.

Show rings will be partially under tent, and shady crating space will be available.

**ELIGIBLE SCOTTISH BREEDS:** Golden Retriever, Gordon Setter, Scottish Deerhound, Border Terrier, Cairn Terrier, Dandie Dinmont Terrier, Scottish Terrier, Skye Terrier, West Highland White Terrier, Bearded Collie, Border Collie, Collie (Rough & Smooth), and Shetland Sheepdog.

**BREED CLASSES:** (No Champions in the Breed Classes, please) - Divided by sex:  
Puppy 3-6 months, Puppy 6-9 months, Puppy 9-12 months, & Open Class  
Best of Breed or Variety will compete in either Terrier or Non-Terrier Group for Best in Match.

**OTHER CLASSES:** Clipped Classes will be offered for all Terriers not in show coat. Household pets are encouraged to enter for all breeds.

**"WEE BEASTIE" SCOTTISH COSTUME CLASS:** Strictly for fun. Conformation doesn't count and family pets are welcome. Dogs (handlers, too, if you wish) should be "dressed up" with a Scottish flavor, and will be judged solely on originality, colorfulness, and overall Scottish personality.

**AWARDS:** Ribbons for all class placements (1-2-3-4). Rosettes and a Scottish Festival T-shirt for Best of Breed or Variety. Rosettes for 1st in Group Placements. "Best of Match" winner will receive Mark Owen Memorial Trophy.

**REGISTRATION AND ENTRY FEE:** There is no entry fee, per se, for the match. **HOWEVER**, each person will be charged \$15.00 admission (adult) to the Festival Grounds, entitling the ticket holder to participate in all of the day's activities and entertainment throughout the grounds. Judging begins at 10:00 a.m.**

**COMMENTS:** All Best of Breed or Variety winners and their exhibitors are encouraged (but not required) to participate in the Opening Day Parade and Ceremonies at 1 p.m. Any other exhibitors and their dogs who would like to are welcome to participate as well. Although by NO means a requirement, exhibitors are encouraged to wear Scottish attire. For men, the kilt! Or a tartan tie. For women, tartan skirt, blouse or sash, or perhaps a tam. Anything that says "Scotland"! Scottish and American foods and beverages will be available all day at several locations throughout the grounds. **PARKING:** Loading and unloading may be done at the dog show gate (west side near rings), but you may NOT park in that area. Tickets will be collected from all who enter, and hands stamped for easy reentry, so please purchase your ticket at the Main (South) Gate FIRST. Parking is \$5.00 in designated areas of the paved stadium parking lot. There are NO hookups available for RV's or motor homes.

**DIRECTIONS TO THE FESTIVAL:** From Fort Worth, east on I-30; from Dallas, west on I-30. From I-30, east or west, take the Fielder Road exit south, approximately 3 miles to Mitchell. East on Mitchell to Maverick Stadium. Show site is in the southwest corner of the stadium grounds.
